RACISM- AND THE RSSL

Not so long ago someone circulated an e-mail about a statement the Australian Prime Minister(sic ex P.M) is supposed to have made regarding Shariya Law and his views and Australian Society. It appeared that the sender of this e-mail is a well known member of the RSSL. This prompted a member to inquire politely whether the RSSL had anything to do with it, while another member some weeks later obviously on second-hand information sent a letter accusing the RSSL of being racist and wanting to resign. It is also learnt that he is asking some other members to resign accusing the RSSL of being racist. As Editor and Secretary I would like to categorically state that the RSSL has had nothing to do with any such thing and that what members do in their private capacity has no connection with the official activities of the RSSL. It will help all of us if people act with more maturity and a sense of responsibility. At the same time it might be in order to state that forwarding e-mails to others who have not agreed to receive such is a violation of the privacy act. The RSSL has made available a membership directory in the form of a call book which is purely for QSL purposes and private use and not for unauthorised use. Careless use of e-mails can cause great harm and it goes without saying that great care should be exercised before sending out e-mails. Some have the habit of using work place computers, which can cause great harm to their workplaces and their own position in the firm by the indiscriminate use of e-mail.
